## PURPOSE OF THE REPORT:

To provide a summary of the recommendations within the independent cancer taskforce; the new cancer strategy for England and the potential implications for the Trust.

## KEY POINTS:

The report by the Independent Cancer Taskforce proposes a strategy for improving radically the outcomes that the NHS delivers for patients with cancer. It provides 96 recommendations to improve the prevention, diagnosis, treatment and care of cancer in England. The attached document:

- Provides a summary of the objectives and priorities of the strategy.
- Identifies those recommendations which are most likely to impact upon the Trust.

The next steps include:

- The Cancer Management Executive will continue to reassess the recommendations as further information becomes available.
- Further engagement and alignment of priorities is planned with NHS Sheffield CCG.
- Cancer Waiting Times breach allocation guidance is to follow and will need to be considered along with the strategy document and NICE guidance to ensure that the whole system is working coherently together.
- Creation of an Implementation Plan to be brought back to TEG for further debate in April 2016.
