There is a huge range of products available, including iPhones, iPads, Laptops, TV's, Gaming Consoles, Fridge Freezers, Dishwashers to name but a few!

 - Select goods from the range of products available and place your order – upto a maximum of £3,000 (subject to National Minimum Wage checks)
 - Await authorisation from the employer to Vivup
 - Track your order online
 - Receive delivery of your goods before your first payroll deduction
