How to use the drive through blood taking service.

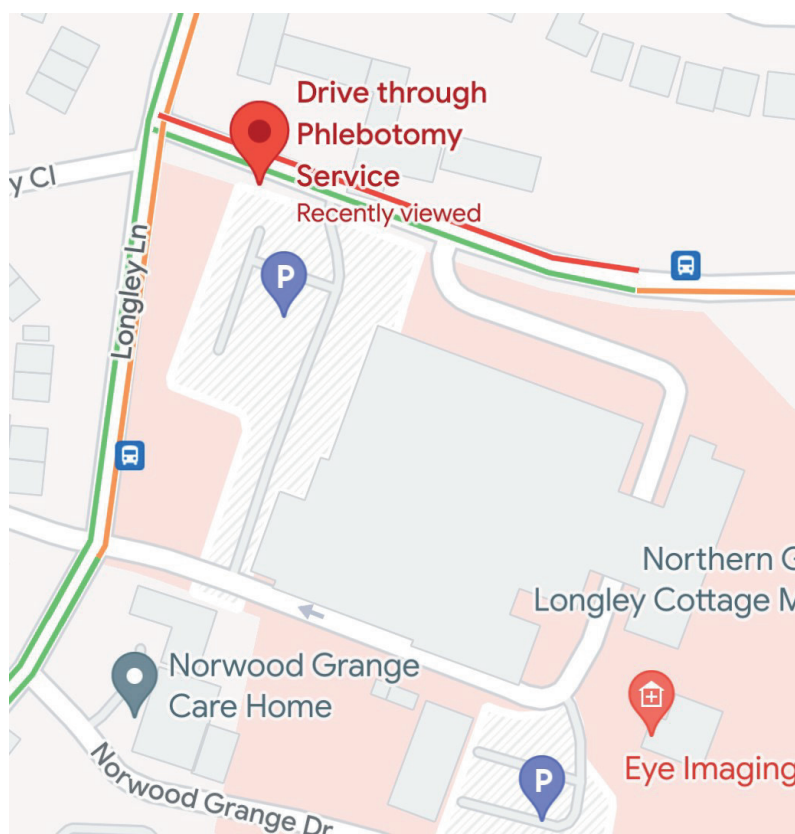
In order to prioritise the safety of both patients and staff, it is imperative that you remain inside your vehicle throughout the entire process.

If your doctor has recommended a blood test and you have access to a car, and if the necessary tests have been booked, your NHS number has been provided, or you have a blood request form, kindly proceed to our drive through facility for your blood test.

The entrance to the facility is located on Longley Hall Road. Upon your arrival, a steward will guide you to the designated phlebotomy area.

You will then be directed to a phlebotomist. Please ensure your car engine is turned off, lower your window, and carefully follow the instructions provided by the phlebotomist.

There are no public toilet facilities on-site. However, you'll find convenient public toilets at the Northern General Hospital.



Important notice: It is essential that you arrive in a vehicle.

The drive-through does not cater for individuals walking in, cycling, or riding motorbikes.

The walk-in service is at C-floor at the Royal Hallamshire Hospital and Hunstman Outpatients at the Northern General Hospital.
